ORDINANCE 2019-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §10-102.2 OF THE READING TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING VEGETATIVE GROWTH BEING A NUISANCE UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

SECTION 1. There shall be added to §10-102.2 of the Reading Township Code of Ordinances a second sentence as follows:

"Further, this Part shall not include vegetation that has been deliberately planted and is maintained and /or managed pursuant to an approved Operation and Maintenance Plan, intended for the useful purpose of inclusion as a stormwater measure and/or best management practice."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective pursuant to law.




